I write regarding Uniform arrangements over the next month or so ahead of students returning to the academy for the new academic year on Wednesday 2 September 2015 at 8.20am

Firstly, Year 6 students were measured for their new uniform last week. They will receive a jacket, 1 pair of trousers or a skirt, 2 shirts, a tie, and a PE kit comprising of a polo shirt, shorts, rugby shirt and PE socks. Shirts, trousers and skirts have the Outwood logo embroidered onto the fabric.

Year 6 parents can collect the uniform from the academy on Wednesday 29 July between 10am and 3pm. In order to make this run as smoothly as possible it would be very helpful if parents came along at the following times if they are able, but of course can come at any time if not:

We are also running further 'Uniform Events' on Wednesday 29 July and Tuesday 18 August between 10.00-3.00pm. At these, parents and students from any Year will have the opportunity to come into school to order additional items of uniform, try them on for size, and pay for them rather than having to use the online service. The items will then be delivered to your home.

The event will be held in the Main Hall, and access will not be via Reception, but by the double fire doors leading directly into the Main Hall.

You will be aware that the school requires that students wear our branded uniform, when they have grown out of the free uniform provided or require additional spare items.
