### **Timetable arrangements for Year 11 from Monday 13 June 2016**

As you will be aware your son/daughter is into the last week of the GCSE examinations, working hard in school to access as much time and support as possible in order to do his/her very best. Students have been particularly keen to seek extra time for subjects where they have been released from completed subjects, where they have sat the examination and finished coursework.

It is a genuine pleasure to see Year 11 spread throughout the school working in spare classrooms or offices on the subjects that are a priority for them, or completing their ECDL qualification, or doing extra work for a subject where they need more support.

I am sure you are as proud of your son/daughter as we are. The academy has an impressive culture of learning, in part down to the hard work, focus and commitment that Year 11 (and Year 10) are showing to younger students during a particularly challenging examination season.

I write to give you a brief overview of how your son/daughter's timetable will look from Monday 13 June. Your child will also receive a personalised timetable showing remaining exams, masterclasses and when to attend. You will have already seen your child's examination timetable and the list of breakfast and 'masterclass' revision sessions taking place before each exam. There are some changes to masterclasses:

**Mon 13 June** Y11 attend **ALL DAY** if they are studying **History, Child Development, Catering, ICT** or have yet to complete ECDL. Other students are welcome but not required.

**Tues 14 June** **ALL Y11 attend from 8.20 – 11.00** but can then go home unless in the History Exam. There is a 7.30am ICT Revision Breakfast Session for students with an AM ICT Exam.

**Wed 15 June** Y11 attend **ALL DAY** for AM Chemistry Masterclasses, then PM Chemistry Exam.

**Thur 16 June** Y11 attend from **8.20 – 11.00** for AM Physics Masterclasses but can then go home unless still completing the ECDL qualification.

**Fri 17 June** Y11 attend from **8.20 (7.30)** for AM Physics Exam but can then go home unless still completing the ECDL qualification. There is a 7.30am Physics Revision Breakfast for all students.
