To provide you with further details regarding the residential, I would like to take this opportunity to invite you to attend an information meeting on **Tuesday 19 June at 5pm** in the Main Hall. We are hopeful every parent can attend as important information will be discussed.

The Kingswood Residential is about the activities and the outdoor experience. This will be an excellent chance for your child to mix with other students in their year group and bond with friends, old and new. Students will be divided into teams and will be advised which team they belong to prior to the trip. The accommodation is basic; all bedding is supplied but students will need to bring their own towels. I have also attached a recommended kit list.

Room types are varied and we will do our best to ensure that pupils are sharing with other students they feel comfortable with. **Please ask your son/daughter to complete the attached form to help us allocate rooms.** All meals will be provided; however, students are allowed to bring some tuck shop/souvenir shop money (recommended maximum of £5.00).

For safeguarding reasons students are not permitted to bring mobile phones.

There are no lockers in the centre; therefore, we strongly advise that students do not bring valuable items. We have taken the decision to prohibit electrical items (iPads, iPods, MP3 players, etc.) and school will not be held responsible for any damage or loss as a result of children bringing prohibited items.

To ensure the comfort and safety of your child during the activity sessions we recommend that your child brings the following kit:

Please ensure all clothing is clearly labelled! *compulsory

- One bath towel for showering*
- Toiletries bag containing: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hairbrush etc.
- Night clothes
- Spare socks and underwear*
- T-shirts, shirts, blouses (at least one with long-sleeves)
- Three pairs of trousers and/or tracksuit bottoms/jogging bottoms/leggings
- Clothes for the evening activities
- Waterproof jacket (and trousers if you have them)
- Wellies
- Hair bobbles
- Old trainers or similar in case of wet weather
- Training shoes for dry activities*
- Large plastic bag/bin liner for dirty clothes
- Gloves
- Sun hat or cap
- Insect repellent
- Water bottle (refill stations available)
- Sun cream*
- Warm jumpers/fleeces/Sweatshirt

Please note that most activities require long sleeves.

This list is not exhaustive; weather dependent your child may not need all of the above (i.e. waterproof trousers). Old clothing is recommended. A drying room is available.

All specialist equipment will be provided by the centre, so there is no need to purchase costly items.
