Outwood Academy Bydales Sports Day – Wednesday 18 July 2018

I am delighted to inform you that the Outwood Academy Bydales Sports Day will take place on **Wednesday 18 July 2018** during Transition Week. Year 6 students will play an active part in events and this will provide them with the opportunity to mix with other students of all ages in their Continent.

The start and finish times of the Academy day remain the same, with students required to be on site at 8.20am and in their VMG room by 8.25am. The usual teaching timetable will be collapsed to accommodate the schedule of events, which will form the basis of a Sports Day competition. All students are expected to attend the Academy as normal and we would encourage 100% attendance from students to help make the day a success.

All students are expected to attend the academy wearing their full PE kit, Year 6 students should come to school in their primary school PE Kit. At the start of the day students will be given a coloured t-shirt to wear, which will represent the continent they belong to.

There are no changes to the normal lunchtime with food available in the canteen as usual.

Students should bring with them a bottle of water to aid rehydration during the day. However, students are not permitted to bring any banned items such as fizzy drinks as part of any refreshments. Students should also ensure that they have sunscreen on and that they bring some extra with them to reapply through-out the day. Students must also bring a sun hat or cap to avoid sunstroke, as the weather forecast continues to show unusually high temperatures.

Unfortunately, parents are unable to attend the Sports Day, due to the size of the event. I trust that you will understand the scale of this Olympic event.
