Sports Leaders 2018-2019

Your son/daughter has been selected as a Sports Leader for 2018-2019, as a result of their attitude within PE lessons and a strong written application.

This year the Sports Leaders will work towards achieving the Sports Leaders UK Level 2 qualification. Throughout the course students will cover the following four units:

- Developing leadership skills
- Plan, lead and evaluate sport/physical activity
- Assist in planning and leading a sports/physical activity event
- Lead sport/physical activity sessions linked to the community/centre

Training for the Sports Leaders UK Level 2 qualification will take place on Mondays between 3.30pm and 4.30pm each week with Mrs Hill in the Autumn term (September-December). In addition to this there are approximately 15 Primary School events that our School Sports Coordinator (Mr Buckby) requires support with. Students are not expected to attend all events, however, they are expected to attend the majority. If students are unable to support an event or attend training they should let Mrs Hill know as soon as possible. **This is very important, as if we are not able to staff events we may need to adapt the event set up.** Where possible, if students can find an alternative student this would be very helpful.

For Sports Leaders in 2018-2019, students will be asked to make a voluntary contribution of £40. This will partly cover the cost of the Level 2 Sports Leaders Qualification (individual cost of £31), whistles and an Outwood Academy Bydales Purple Sports Leader hoodie with embroidered initials. The hoodies are in adult sizes (S, M, L, XL) and are allowed to be worn in PE lessons and to any events which students are involved in.

Please indicate on the reply slip the two initials to be embroidered on the front, the size required and include full payment before 3pm 16 July 2018.
