Outwood Academy Bydales Sports Day – Monday 24 June 2019

I am delighted to inform you that the Outwood Academy Bydales Sports Day will take place on **Monday 24 June 2019**. The start and finish times of the Academy day remain the same, with students required to be on site at 8.20am and reporting to their first lesson by 8.25am. The usual teaching timetable will apply, however students will leave lessons after registering to attend events for which they have been selected. All students are expected to attend the Academy as normal. We would encourage 100% attendance from students to help make the day a success. Any absence will be recorded in line with school policy.

All students are expected to attend the academy wearing their full PE kit to ensure they are suitably dressed to take part in Sports Day whatever their role in the event. At the start of the day students will be given a coloured t-shirt to wear, which will represent the continent they belong to. In line with school policy no hoodies/grey joggers are allowed to be worn on school site. Students are still required to bring their school bags and planners as lessons will still take place throughout the day.

There are no changes to the normal lunch times, with food available in the canteen as usual.

Students should bring with them a bottle of water to aid rehydration during the day. However, students are not permitted to bring any banned items such as fizzy drinks. Students should also ensure that they apply sunscreen and that they bring some extra with them to reapply through-out the day. Students must also bring a sun hat or cap to avoid sunstroke, as the weather forecast continues to show unusually high temperatures.

Unfortunately, parents are unable to attend the Sports Day, due to the size of the event. I trust that you will understand the scale of this Olympic event.
